Funding Opportunity Announcement (FOA) for Sector Partnership Training

The Mayor's Workforce Development Board (MWDB) is directly responsible and accountable to the State of Michigan, Labor and Economic Opportunity-Workforce Development (LEO-WD) for the planning and oversight of talent development programs in the City of Detroit. Designated by the MWDB, Detroit Employment Solutions Corporation (DESC) serves as the fiscal and administrative entity that provides workforce services to job seekers and employers. DESC's primary funding streams include Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA), Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF) that funds Michigan's PATH (Partnership. Accountability. Training. Hope.) employment program, Food Assistance Employment and Training (FAE&T), Wagner-Peyser Employment Services (ES), and other public and private funding. The Corporation enters into contracts with qualified entities to provide workforce development programs and services to job seekers and employers.

DESC is seeking proposals from qualified applicants to provide Sector Partnership Training for DESC and the MWDB, known collectively as Detroit at Work.

DESC plans to award multiple Master Training Agreements and/or contracts for requested services as detailed in this FOA. Prospective applicants must demonstrate their relevant experience and ability to effectively provide services as set forth in this FOA.
